

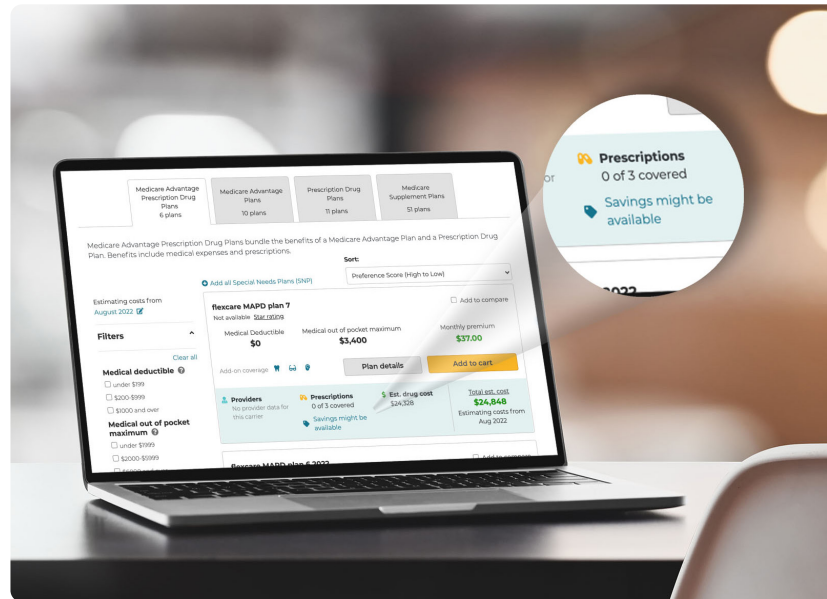
Alternatives for Off-Formulary Drugs

Agents and beneficiaries can now view covered alternatives for medications that are designated as **OFF-formulary (not covered)** by their Medicare plan. Beneficiaries are encouraged to discuss these alternatives with prescribers for a possible change in prescription. These drug alternatives can be lower in cost, or they could have a less frequent dosing schedule, among other benefits.

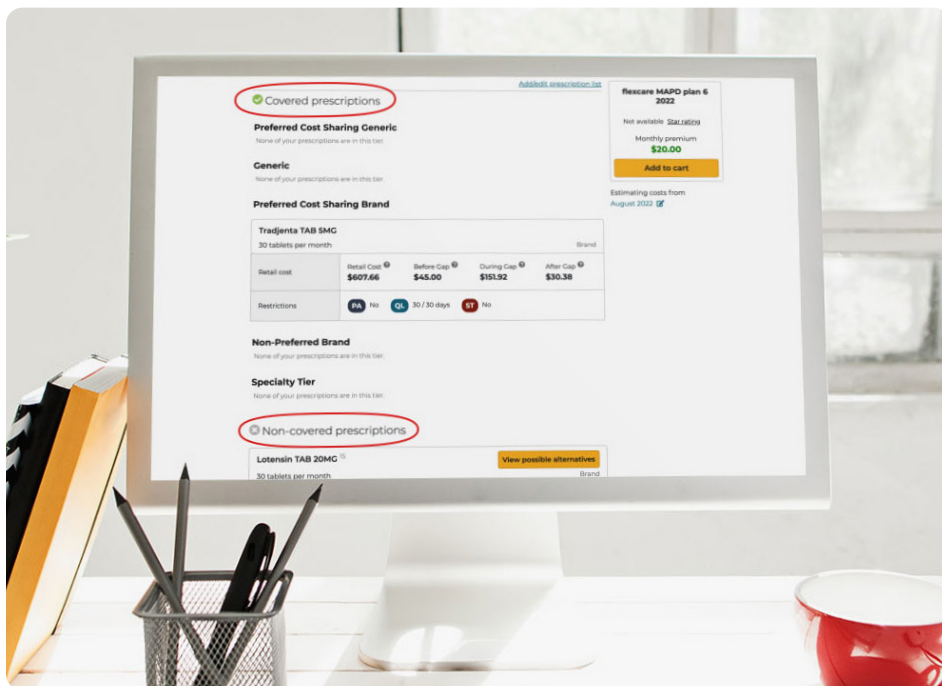
Alternatives for Off-formulary Drugs allows for more informed decision making while beneficiaries shop for plans to ensure the best possible drug coverage and cost. Drug information is maintained by ConnectureDRX clinical staff and reviewed by a P&T committee.

Via this feature, agents and beneficiaries will be able to:

1. Add drugs to their medicine cabinet and see if the drug is NOT covered but has covered alternatives. A “Savings might be available” link appears when there are covered alternatives.



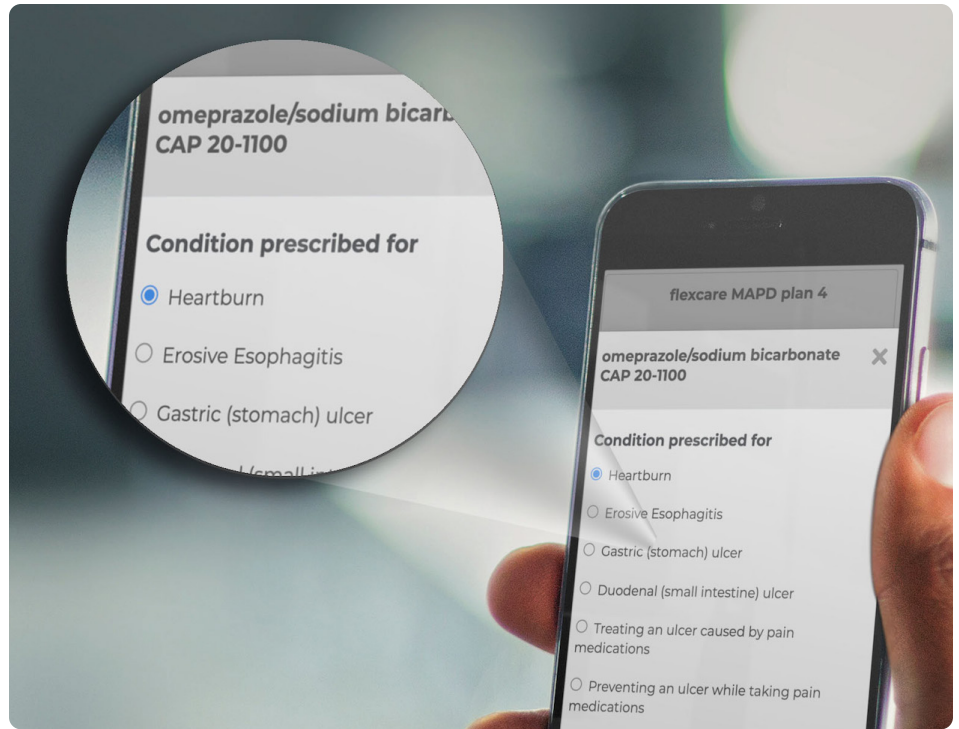
A “Savings TAG” will appear on the plan card, the plan details page and the compare plans page.



2. “View possible alternatives” when a prescription is not covered.

Agents and beneficiaries can see non-covered prescriptions as well as covered prescriptions.

3. **Change the medical condition** for a prescribed drug, if desired, to get a list of possible covered alternatives. This is helpful since different drugs are prescribed for different conditions.



Beneficiaries will get peace of mind knowing there may be lower-cost options available when a drug is not covered by their plan or is off formulary. With complete drug coverage and possible alternative transparency during their shopping and enrollment experience, agents and beneficiaries will be directed to the plan with the best coverage.
